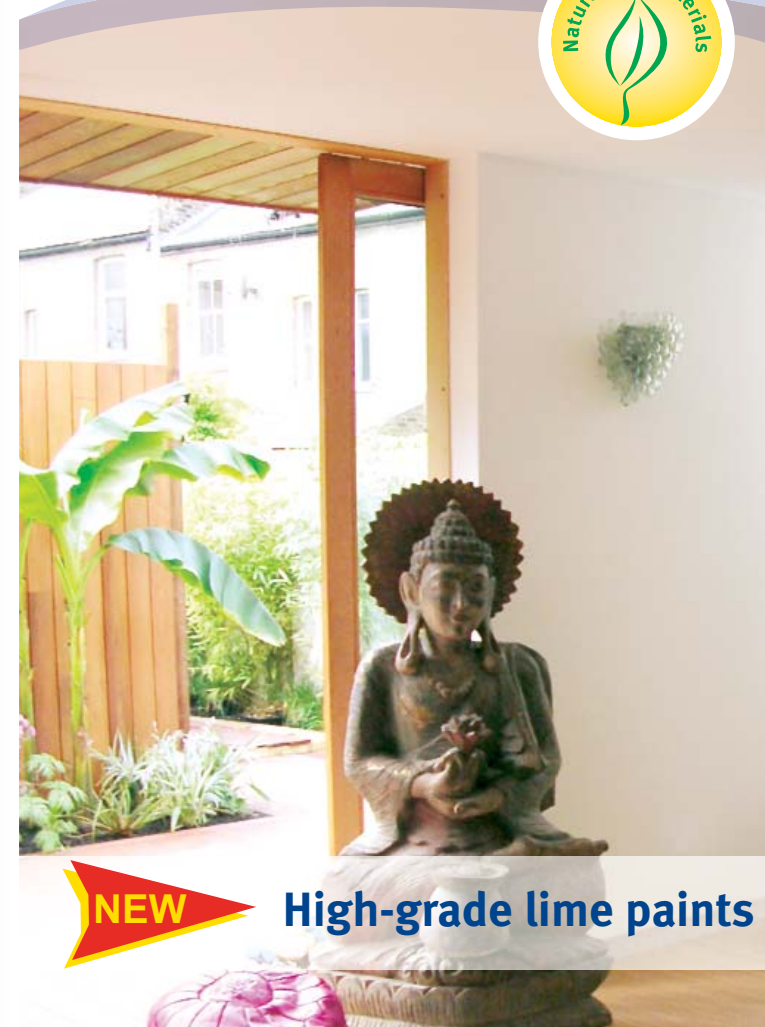

The new professional lime paints

Lime paints, the traditional mineral paints based on aged slaked lime, are enjoying a renaissance: they are the first choice in design both in new buildings and when restoring historic buildings and buildings under preservation orders.

Lime coatings are characterised by excellent properties:



Their moisture-vapour permeability provides for good room air quality. They are suitable for preventing mould growth and also absorb odours. Following the drying process, excellent opacity is obtained even with the first coating. Easy application, good spraying behaviour and ideal drying qualities are convincing arguments for professionals and do-it-yourselfers alike.

AURO now offers an entirely new range of aged slaked lime paints which consists of three high-grade products in professional quality.

These ready-to-use products come in blue buckets and are based on high-grade, specially dispersed aged slaked lime of premium quality. They are universally applicable as they stand out due to their good adhesion to all mineral substrates as well as to woodchip wallpaper, gypsum plasterboard and loam.

High-grade silicate primer no. 306



This high-grade silicate primer is the ideal undercoat for the outdoor application of our high-grade lime paint. Surfaces are perfectly stabilised and silicified. The primer is applied by brush or roller and is recoatable after 24 hours. Its white pigmentation improves the opacity of the subsequent coating, especially in the case of dark substrates. The primer completely silicifies with other mineral substrates.

Spreading rate: 10 l suffice for up to 100 m²

High-grade lime paint no. 344

This high-grade lime paint contains no plastic-based binders and can be used both inside and outside. It is suitable for most substrates, including gypsum plasterboard. During application it first has a slightly transparent effect.



It attains its full opacity once it is fully dry. Professionals highly appreciate its good workability and adhesion.

Spreading rate: 10 l suffice for up to 100 m²

High-grade lime plaster no. 345

This ready-to-use plaster is suitable for indoors and basements. Thanks to its unique product qualities it is also recommended for damp rooms. Its fine-grained texture provides for very decorative surfaces which breathe at the same time. Absorptive substrates are primed with diluted lime paint. The lime plaster can be applied to the walls by roller or brush. Different textures are obtained depending on the application method.



Spreading rate: 15 kg suffice for up to 45 m²

Coloured tinting

Those who like colours can tint lime products with AURO Lime-casein coloured paint no. 770 for indoor use. Add max. 5% of coloured paint mixed with water to obtain individually designed coatings in pastel colours.

The typical appearance of coloured lime paint coatings is a matt surface with a cloudy effect. We recommend AURO High-grade lime paint no. 344 without tinting for outdoor use.
