Breathe again and feel well – with AURO Airfresh wallpaint

The main purpose of a wallpaint is to beautify rooms. A new generation of wallpaint offers much more than the visual advantages of a fresh coat of paint. AURO Airfresh wallpaint combines a pure white surface with the permanent degradation of pollutants, smells and germs. Thus a pleasant room climate is maintained.

How does it work?

The special raw material combination of AURO Airfresh wallpaint makes the product work like a biocatalyst that, with the help of light, splits up air pollutants into neutral substances. The best effects are achieved in rooms that have daylight but it also works under the influence of artificial light.

The process of degradation does not decrease, the effectiveness remains constant until the coat has to be renewed. Just like every room, also rooms painted with AURO Airfresh wallpaint should be regularly ventilated. Movement of the air is necessary to transport the pollutants in the direction of the wall where they can get in touch with the wall paint and can be degraded.



Thick air

There are many things that can lead to 'thick air' within rooms. AURO Airfresh wallpaint permanently neutralizes the odours coming from smoke or cooking, and evaporations from furniture or carpets. Moreover, pollutants (e.g. organic compounds) and microorganisms like bacteria are degraded.

AURO Airfresh wallpaint is the only wallpaint with a photocatalytic effect that works on the basis of consistently ecological raw materials, without the inclusion of any acrylics or other petrochemicals.

Examined quality

Scientists of the Institute of Technical Chemistry in Hanover have carried out exemplary tests and confirmed the photocatalytic effect of AURO Airfresh wallpaint.

Easy application

AURO Airfresh wallpaint is a low-odour, solvent-free, white wallpaint. Due to its alkalinity, it also has an inhibiting effect on microorganisms like mould spores, viruses and bacteria. It can be applied by roll or brush. The product has a good yield, up to 100 m² can be painted with 10,0 L.

If you prefer a coloured paint coat to the pure white the Airfresh wallpaint can be tinted in pastel tones with AURO Lime-casein coloured paints No. 770. The pigmentation will, however, slightly diminish the photocatalytic effect. AURO Airfresh wallpaint can be painted over old paint coats. A reworking of a surface painted with Airfresh wallpaint should be carried out with the same product although other AURO wallpaints can also be used for renovation. In any case, a sample coating on a small spot is recommended to test product compatibility.

How does it work?



In the course of time, odours and pollutants gather on walls and ceilings.

Activated by sunlight, AURO Airfresh wallpaint splits up these particles into neutral substances.

AURO Airfresh wallpaint cares for permanently fresh room air and is especially valuable where a room is subject to extraordinary charges, e.g. schools, conference rooms, hotels, restaurants, but also in living rooms, bedrooms, nurseries, kitchens ...
